The 'Leicestershire Community' web site serves as a distribution point for the communityPortals software package and provides a gateway to the various implementations of communityPortals that are currently in operation.

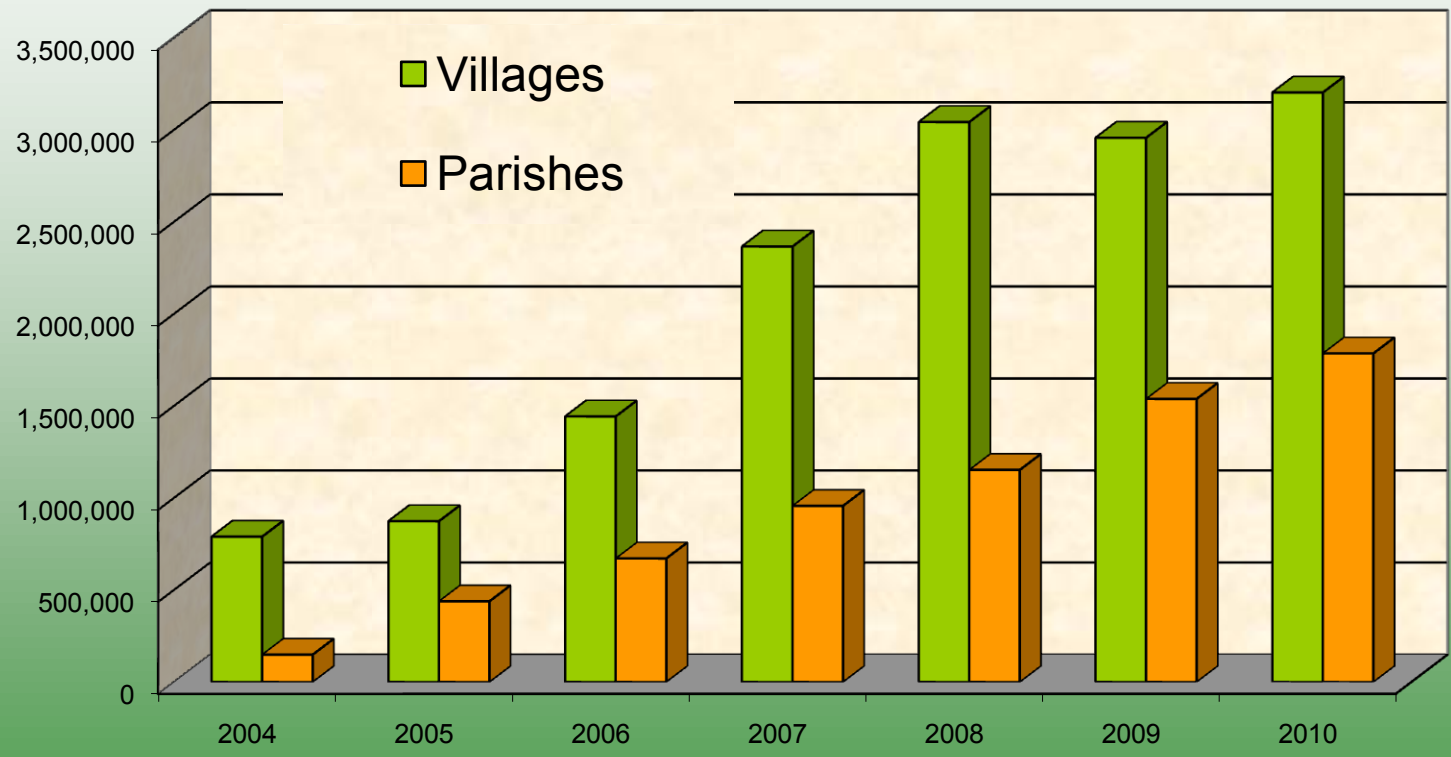
