

A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - 2012-based population predictions of over 65 age group

Using 2012-based Subnational Population Projections for England (Office for National Statistics), the attached analysis looks at the projected proportion of total residents in an authority that are over 65, and provides a comparison to the rural and urban averages. The analysis covers the 25 year period from 2012 to 2037.

Using the mouse, select this cell (containing a local authority name).

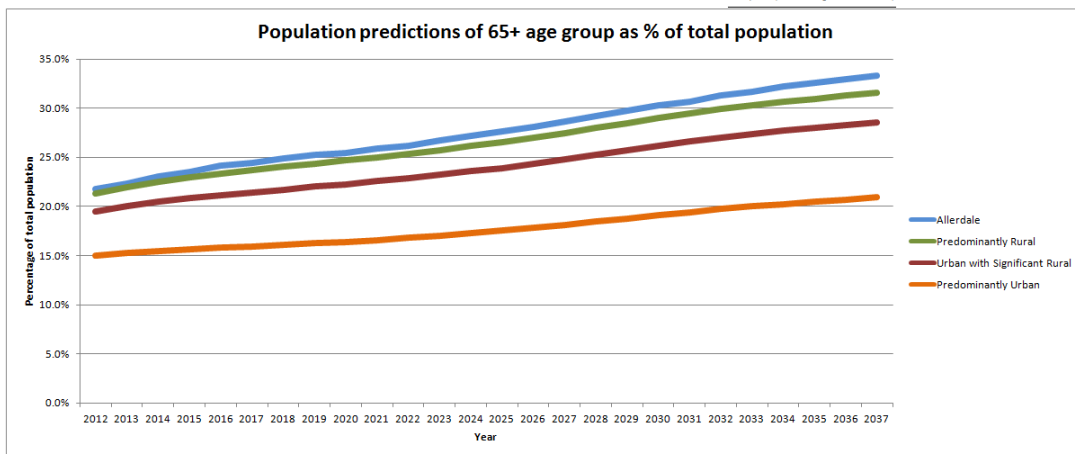
To the right of the cell, a grey square with a blue triangle appears. Clicking on this presents the full list of options available.

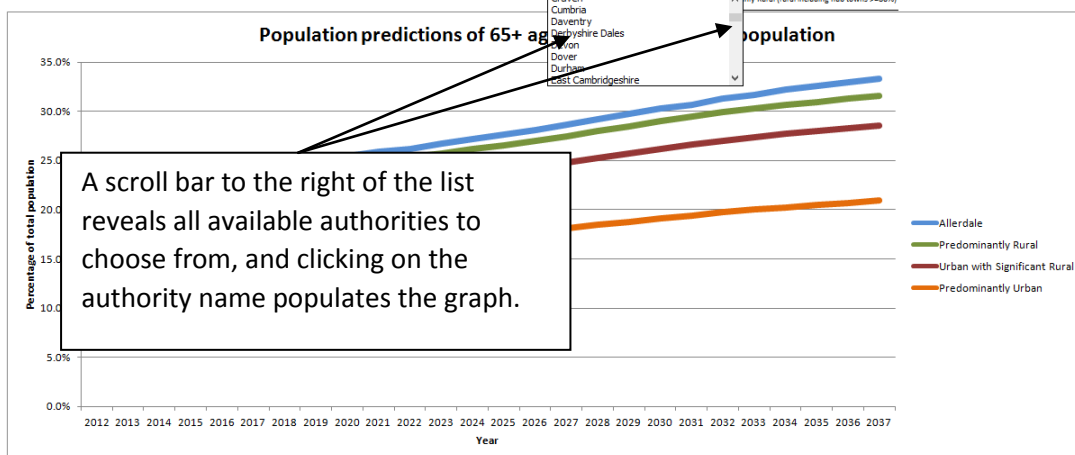
