

A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - Second Home Ownership in your Authority

Using data collected for the Calculation of Council Tax Base for Formula Grant Purposes, it has been possible to present as a percentage of total dwellings on the valuation list the proportion that are classed as second homes (data from Statistics section, GOV.UK).

The spreadsheet looks at the situation in a local authority, and compares it to the situation in authorities of similar rural/urban population classification. It presents the situation over the past 3 years, and shows the ranked situation against local authorities in the same rural/urban population classification.

To use the spreadsheet please follow these instructions:

Using the mouse, select this cell (containing a local authority name).

To the right of the cell, a grey square with a blue triangle appears. Clicking on this presents the full list of options available.
