

**A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - Revenue Outturn Summary - Net Current Expenditure**

This analysis provides a view of the Revenue Outturn, Net Current Expenditure, for each of the service areas for the years 2009/10 to 2014/15. The analysis provides the expenditure per head for each service area, the corresponding percentage of total service expenditure, and in both cases an average for authorities of same class and classification. (data from Department for Communities and Local Government / ONS)

To use the spreadsheet, please follow these steps:

1) Using the mouse, select the cell containing a local authority name.

2) To the right of the chosen cell, a grey square with a blue triangle appears. Clicking on this presents the full list of options available.




