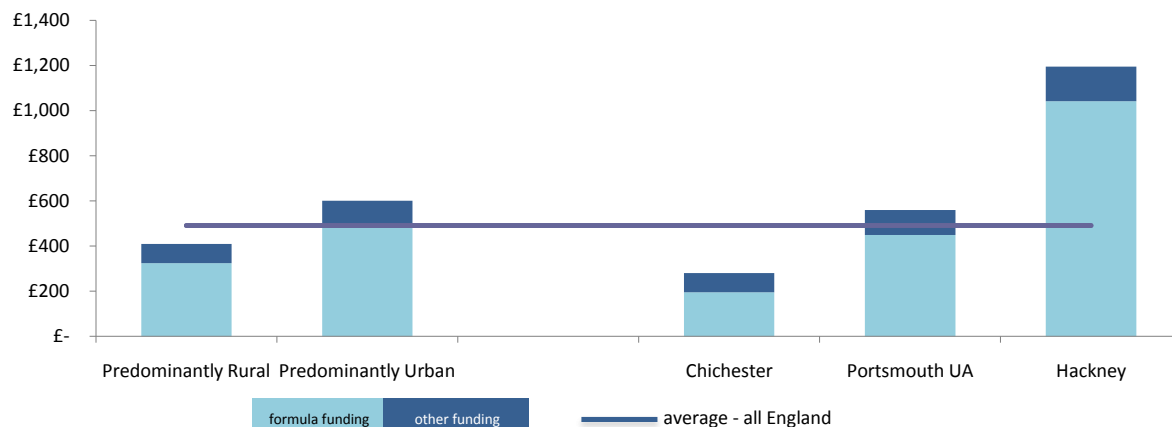

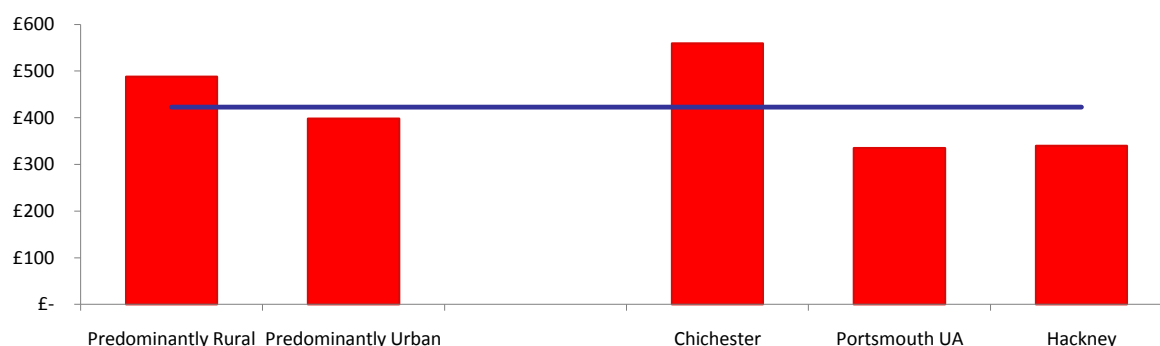
## Government Funding per Head

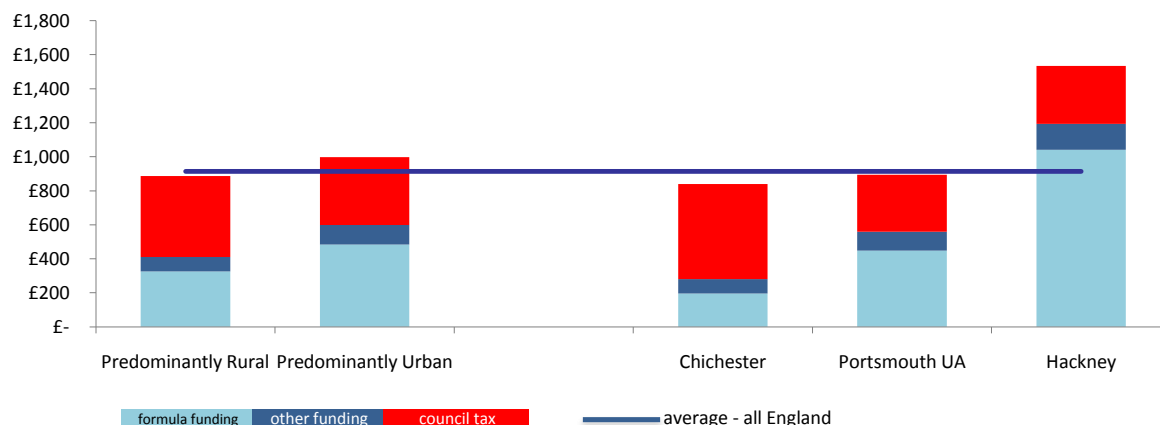
