Transformation Challenge Award

- Funding which is available to support local authorities transform their operations, make changes to business processes and work with the wider public sector to improve services for local people.
- It aims to reward plans to improve services for people and to support imaginative ideas that will have a significant impact.

Year	Amount	Purpose
2013-2014	£6.9 Million Revenue Grant	Awarded through local authorities bidding – competitive process
2014-2015	£9 Million Revenue Grant	Awarded through local authorities bidding – competitive process
2014-2015	£6 Million Revenue Grant	Awarded to authorities that narrowly missed out in 13-14 allocations
2015-2016	£105 Million Revenue Grant	Awarded through local authorities bidding – competitive process
2015-2016	£200 Million Flexible use of Capital Receipts	Awarded through local authorities bidding – competitive process

Urban Authorities	£6.4 Million 29.7%
