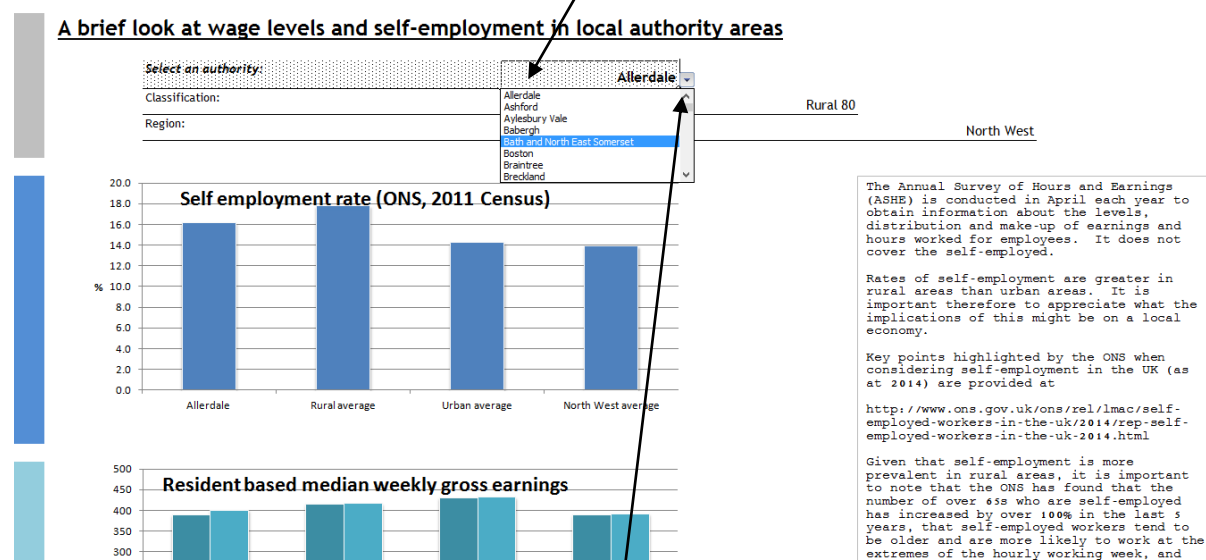


A Guide to RSN Online Spreadsheets - A brief look at wage levels and self-employment in local authority areas

Bringing together data from the Office for National Statistics, it is possible to build up a clear picture of lower average income for those working in rural areas. This has obvious implications in terms of living standards and affordability of housing, transport, as well as the ability to live rewarding, active and healthy lifestyles.

The RSN analysis looks to show the basis of the generalised situation in rural areas, and also to show the specific situation in any chosen member local authority area.

This option box allows the user to select the local authority of interest.



Using the mouse to select this option cell reveals a grey square with a blue triangle to the right of the option. Clicking on the grey square then reveals the full list of options to select from.
