

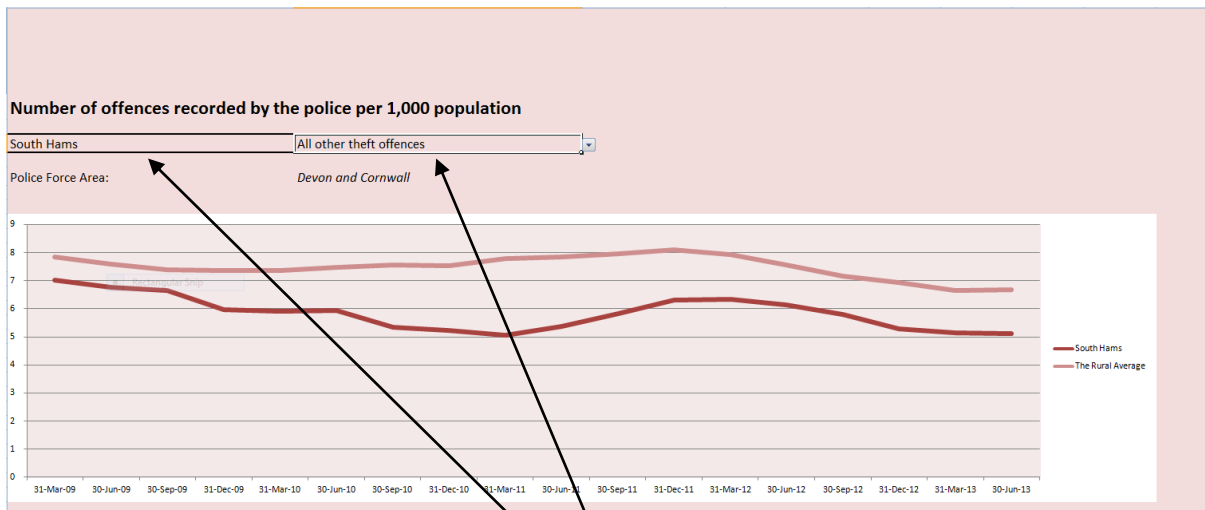
A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – Police recorded crime and workforce information

The attached spreadsheet presents information on crime in your local authority area, and associated police authority.

The spreadsheet allows the user to select the local authority of interest, and the crime for which data is required. The first graph then presents the information for the local authority area, the remaining bar charts present data for the police authority in which the local authority resides.

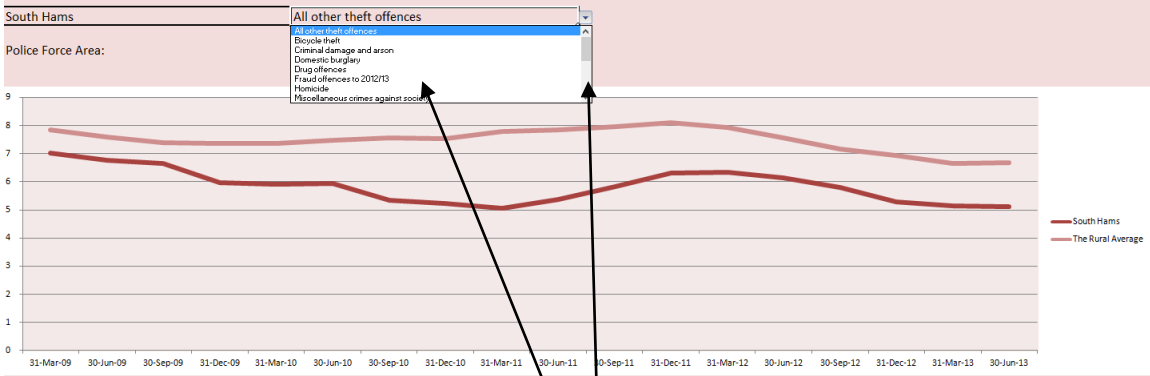
Data used in this spreadsheets construction comes from the Office for National Statistics, Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary, and the Home Office.

To select your chosen options, please follow these instructions:



Select either of these cells. A grey square with a blue triangular arrow head will appear to the right of the cell.

Number of offences recorded by the police per 1,000 population



Clicking on the grey square with the blue triangular arrow head will present the full list from which to select. A scroll bar to the right allows complete access to the list of options.

NB. No data exists in 2012/13 for the Essex police force area due to an administrative error.
